Beyond the Bell Inclement Weather – Beyond the Bell after school outdoor space childcare for inclement weather which includes excessive heat, high winds and rain.

Walking Gate Update: We have made improvements to the Walking Gate on Mason. On Mason sidewalk, there will be cones set out for parents to line-up according to the grade level they are picking up. In order for us to expedite the service by grade level, please line up behind the grade level cones.

- o TK, K and 1st grade **only** parents will be processed first for 11:00 AM pick up
- o Followed by 2nd grade 3rd grade parents at 11:15 AM, then 4th grade & 5th grade parents at 11:30 AM
- If you have siblings in different grade levels, we highly recommend coming to the older sibling's dismissal time. Younger siblings will be supervised while waiting in their designated area for us to bring them to you when you arrive. If you choose to pick up at the earlier child's pick-up time, you will need to get back in line again to pick up the older child.

1st grade Students Carline Pick-Up: Students will remain in the breezeway by the main office waiting to be called to the carline. Please be on time, pick up starts promptly at 11:00 AM. Parents may line up beginning at 10:45 AM in the carline.

For 2nd grade thru 5th Grade Carline Pick-Up:

- 2nd & 3rd Grade pick up starts at 11:15 PM, line up begins at 11:00 PM
- 4th & 5th Grade pick up starts at 11:30 PM, line up begins at 11:15 PM

Please have a discussion with your children every day before drop off about plans for pick up. Best plan is to keep the pick-up location consistent. Please look out for your child and tell your child to look out for your car as well. **3 options for pick up locations:**

Carline, Walking Gate on Mason, or Beyond the Bell (If in BTB, students will be taken to their BTB cohort)

To make the pick-up carline a success, parents will need to come to carline on time and not before the grade level dismissal time. If upper grades parents come too early to wait in the carline, we do not have space to let parents of students in the 1st grade reach the pick up spots in the carline which slows the process down for everyone. 

Message from School Nurse, Mrs. Press: This is an important message regarding 7th grade immunization requirements. Students must have a Tdap immunization, as well as the 2nd dose of Varicella on file at school to advance to the 7th grade. If your child has already received these immunizations, please bring in or fax a copy of the shot record to the school. If your child has not had either of these immunizations, please schedule an appointment with your medical provider. Students who do not show proof of these immunizations will not be cleared to enter 7th grade in the fall. Notification letters will be sent home to those students who are missing immunizations starting next week. Students Starting 7th Grade Need:

- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) —1 dose (Whooping cough booster usually given at 11 years and up)
- Varicella (Chickenpox) 2 doses (Usually given at ages 12 months and 4-6 years)

In addition, the TK/K-12 immunization requirements apply to 7th graders who:

- previously had a valid personal beliefs exemption filed before 2016 upon entry between TK/Kindergarten and 6th grade
- are new admissions

Records:

California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization.

Middle School Carline & Walk Up Gate on Sesnon:

For safety of our students, we need everyone's cooperation to drive with caution and follow the traffic laws. All working together will also expedite the process during drop off and pick up. Please be attentive and follow the guidance of our staff members.

No parking in the carline and no double parking will be allowed. If students are walking home, please talk with your child/ren about using only the cross walk and no jay walking. Middle school students may not be on campus after dismissal for their safety. All middle school students will be released from the Sesnon Gate at dismissal.





- Due to the lack of cell and internet reception near the school area, print or take a screen shot of the Daily Pass. Daily Pass must be done daily after 7:00 AM. Be sure to send the Daily Pass with your child/ren if they are using the walk up gate.
- Once the Sesnon Gate closes at 9:00 AM, student must check in for temp check and QR code at the main office. Sesnon Gate is for middle school students use ONLY.




