Good evening PRCS Families. Thank you for your continued support as we reopened and adapted to accommodate the many challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic. We want to take this opportunity to provide you with an update regarding state standardized testing as well as local assessments. Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments (SBAC), which are part of the California Assessments of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) system, will not be administered this year in grades 3-8. Instead, the District has decided that for Spring 2021, students in grades 3-8 will take the currently planned District assessments, as provided in the Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan. We have a special Coffee with the Principal for our parents of 5th and 8th grade students, which will be on Tuesday, May 25th at 5:00 PM. The purpose of this Zoom is to provide parents with guidance for in-person, outdoor celebration and culmination ceremonies for the Class of 2021. Information covered is intended to assist students, families, and staff to celebrate this achievement in a safe manner while limiting the spread of COVID-19. This meeting is for families to review the end of the year plans and event protocols that all guests must adhere by to participate in this year's events. This will be a different way of doing our celebration and culmination, but we will work to make it a memorable one for our students.

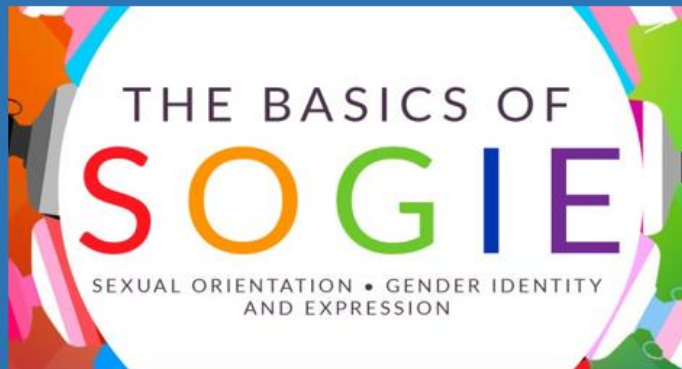

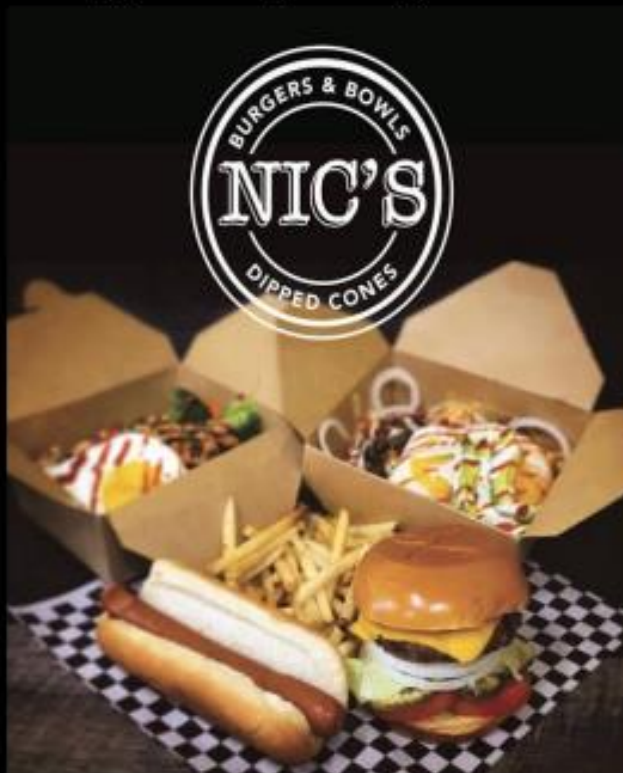
