Los Angeles Unified School District is expanding Safe Steps to Safe Schools Initiative to include mobile vaccination to all middle school and high school students' ages 12 - 18 years old. Students age 12 and older are welcome to get vaccinated. Parents may book appointments for their children using [DailyPass.lausd.net](https://www.dailypass.lausd.net) and find a location near you. Parents must sign a consent form for students to be vaccinated. Students 12-15 must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or responsible adult (named on consent form).

- **All students must pre-register using the Daily Pass program in order to obtain a vaccine or enter campus.**
- A consent form is required for all minors ages 12 through 17 at each visit.
 - 16 and 17-year-olds should be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian, if possible. If this is not possible, they must bring a consent form signed by their parent or legal guardian.
 - 12 through 15-year-olds must be accompanied by their parent, legal guardian, or a responsible adult.
- A signed copy of the parent consent form will be collected by contracted vaccination staff at the vaccination appointment and submitted centrally for record keeping purposes.
