We are so excited to have our elementary students in their new cohorts back on campus and also virtually. Thank you for your patience and partnership as we worked towards a smooth drop off and pick up process this past week. For our parents of hybrid students, please follow the carline and walk up procedures to make it a success! If you have someone else picking up your child, please be sure to give them the child's grade and teacher information, as this will help with locating the student. Also, a reminder to let your child/ren know what the pick up plan is for the day. Best plan for pick up is a consistent plan.

Reminder: **Elementary** - Every Monday will be Professional Development Day for teacher planning and students have a different schedule. This is only for Mondays!!! **Middle School** - Monday schedule; be sure to check the cohort advisory schedule dates and time. **ES & MS** Tuesday – Friday is regular schedule.

All middle school students who return to campus for hybrid in-person learning must receive a negative COVID test in order to obtain a Daily Pass to enter the campus. Due to the lack of internet / phone service near Porter Ranch Community School, be sure to take a screenshot of the Daily Pass before leaving home. If your child is walking or biking to school, or someone else is dropping off your child – Don't forget to print or send a screen shot of the Daily Pass with student. Students will need a Daily Pass to get on campus.

Important update to Covid testing for students moving forward after their first week on campus: District has shared important news about Covid testing for students moving forward. Once students complete their baseline Covid Test prior to first day back to campus, students will not need to schedule any more

...appointments for a Covid Test. Testing will be moved to school site in the coming weeks. As of today, all 6th thru 8th grade students will still need a baseline Covid Test to start hybrid on campus.

- After students baseline Covid testing prior to first day back on campus, all further testing during the spring 2021 semester will take place at our school site.
- After completing the baseline Covid testing, students do not need to make additional appointments
- Schedules of school-based testing will be announced weekly. More info forthcoming.
- Students participating in school-based testing will remain eligible to receive the Daily Pass QR Code.

Important message for Middle School students returning to campus: Beyond the Bell Services

Middle school only - If you indicated a need for supervision through the Beyond the Bell Program for your MS student, please know that the **Beyond the Bell Supervision is only for MS students on the days that they are NOT with their teachers for Hybrid Instruction.** For details please see Middle School News.

If you have requested a Chromebook and are on the waiting list, we are still waiting for delivery from the District and will be notified as soon as we have available inventory. We have made a change to the Computerwise Program for elementary for the remainder of the school year to be asynchronous work with recorded lessons to give all students equal access to the lessons.

Grab n Go Meals for Hybrid or Virtual Students - Students who return for in-person hybrid instruction will be provided multiple **Grab n Go Meals** at school while students who continue with online learning from home can still pick up meals at the carline between 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM Monday – Friday near the main office. Walking Gate Update: We have made improvements to the Walking Gate on Mason and will have changes starting tomorrow. On Mason, there will be cones set out for parents to line-up according to the grade level they are picking up. In order for us to expedite the service by grade level, please line up behind the grade level cones.

- TK, K and 1st grade **only** parents will be processed first for 11:00 AM pick up
- Followed by 2nd grade – 3rd grade parents at 11:15 AM, then 4th grade & 5th grade parents at 11:30 AM
- **If you have siblings in different grade levels, we highly recommend coming to the older sibling's dismissal time. Younger siblings will be supervised while waiting in their designated area for us to bring them to you when you arrive. If you choose to pick up at the earlier child's pick-up time, you will need to get back in line again to pick up the older child.**

1st grade Students Carline Pick-Up: Students will remain in the breezeway by the main office waiting to be called to the carline. Please be on time, pick up starts promptly at 11:00 AM. Parents may line up beginning at 10:45 AM in the carline.

For 2nd grade thru 5th Grade Carline Pick-Up:

- 2nd & 3rd Grade pick up starts at 11:15 PM, line up begins at 11:00 PM
- 4th & 5th Grade pick up starts at 11:30 PM, line up begins at 11:15 PM

Please have a discussion with your children every day before drop off about plans for pick up. Best plan is to keep the pick-up location consistent. Please look out for your child and tell your child to look out for your car as well. **3 options for pick up locations:**

- Carline , Walking Gate on Mason, or Beyond the Bell (If in BTB, students will be taken to their BTB cohort)

To make the pick-up carline a success, parents will need to come to carline on time and not before the grade level dismissal time. If upper grades parents come too early to wait in the carline, we do not have space to let parents of students in the 1st grade reach the pick up spots in the carline which slows the process down for everyone. We appreciate your partnership as we continue to improve the process. Thank you.

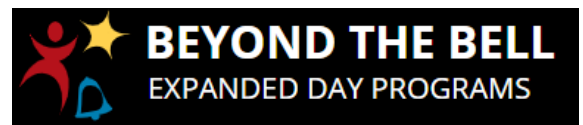
Backpack Essentials for middle school – Chromebooks fully charged, charging cable, and headphones. Lunch will be provided, but you may bring lunch as well. Pack water and extra masks. All drinking fountains are closed. Please ask your teacher about school supplies you may need.

MS – Drop off / Pick up - Carline and Walk up will be on Sesnon for middle school students only. For the carline drop off, students must remain in their vehicle until a temp check and QR Code has been verified and cleared to exit their vehicle to come on campus. For Walk up students, please line up on Sesnon (same direction as carline – see map on the following page), socially distanced and ready to do the temp check and show your QR Code. Parents – please remember to send a snap shot or a print out of the daily pass QR Code in order for students to be admitted onto campus. Sesnon Gate will open at 8:30 AM and will close at promptly at 9:00 AM. If late, students must check in at the main office for temp check and QR Code.

Dismissal for Middle School Students – All students will be dismissed at the Sesnon Gate only. Please communicate with your child whether they will be walking home or will be picked up. For their safety, students cannot remain on campus. See Beyond the Bell news for MS below.

Beyond the Bell News for MS Students

Important message for **middle school students** registered for Beyond the Bell.



If you indicated a need for supervision through the Beyond the Bell Program for your student, please know that the **Beyond the Bell Supervision is only for students on the days that they are NOT with their teachers for Hybrid Instruction.** Your child/ren can come to the Beyond the Bell Supervision on their off days. During their off days while attending Beyond the Bell supervision, your child/ren would meet with their teachers via Zoom, just like if they were at home. Beyond the Bell staff will monitor them and keep them in a classroom or a tent for the day, from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm, again, only during the students' off days.

Cohort H/D - Beyond the Bells days would be: For Mondays - May 10, 24; All Wednesdays & Fridays

Cohort L/G - Beyond the Bells days would be: For Mondays - May 3, 17 June 7; All Tues and Thursdays

Cohort F Virtual Only – virtual only students do not have access to Beyond the Bell Services.

Unfortunately, the Beyond the Bell Supervision program is not open to students on the days they come to school for Hybrid Learning. On these days, your child/ren will follow the school schedule for when the school day starts and ends. At the end of the day, they must be picked up or exit the campus. They are not allowed to remain on campus after school.

If you still like to use the Beyond the Bell Supervision Program you will need to complete the Beyond the Bell application in order to participate. The Beyond the Bell application can be found on our website and you can also come to school to pick up a copy or return a completed copy. Once completed, you could also email the completed application to our main office as well.

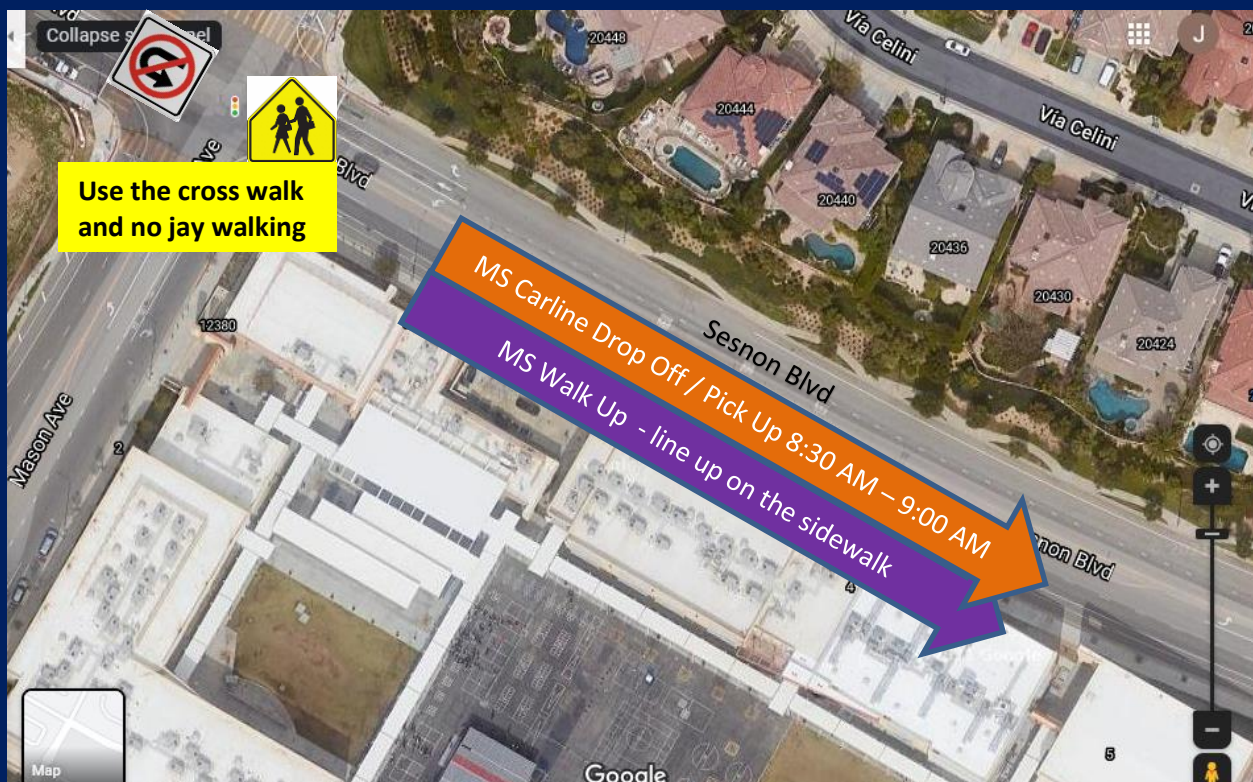

Middle School Carline & Walk Up Gate on Sesnon:

For safety of our students, we need everyone's cooperation to drive with caution and follow the traffic laws. All working together will also expedite the process during drop off and pick up. Please be attentive and follow the guidance of our staff members.

No parking in the carline and no double parking will be allowed. If students are walking home, please talk with your child/ren about using only the cross walk and no jay walking. Middle school students may not be on campus after dismissal for their safety. All middle school students will be released from the Sesnon Gate at dismissal.



- Due to the lack of cell and internet reception near the school area, print or take a screen shot of the Daily Pass. Daily Pass must be done daily after 7:00 AM. Be sure to send the Daily Pass with your child/ren if they are using the walk up gate.
- Once the Sesnon Gate closes at 9:00 AM, student must check in for temp check and QR code at the main office. Sesnon Gate is for middle school students use ONLY.

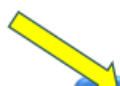
